Ascension Lutheran Church of Navarino is celebrating 150 years - 1874 to 2024



In December of 1869, Martinus and Bertha Anderson prepared their log home in Shawano County for Reverend Homme to conduct a worship service. There was a small group of Norwegian settlers in the area, and they were hungry for the word of God. This was the spark of hope for a Lutheran Church taking root in the community. On November 26th of 1874. those hopes and dreams came to fruition and the

Scandinavian Evangelical Lutheran Church of Navarino was officially organized. The first church building was completed in 1883. The church changed its name to Ascension Lutheran Church on June 26, 1960, and the current church was built in 1977 which is located at W6106 Navarino Road, Shiocton.



'Way Back When by Mabel Prestrud

Some folks may remember the "Imaginary Diary of Karen Kirkedatter" that used to be included with the regular 'Way Back When. Here are a few date entries to reminisce about.

June 5, 1947

Today we witnessed the wedding of Miss Esher Amundson and Rev. G.O. Halverson. The church was packed for the ceremony. The women of our congregation served at the reception following. Esther is the granddaughter of Lars Amundson, one of our charter members, who was mentioned often in the early history of this congregation. We certainly welcome a pastor's wife to the parsonage. Pastor Halverson does much to inspire the choir with good music. He even did a good job of directing the choir on *Gesu Bambino* with a blank piece of paper in his hand! We are now called the "Evangelical Lutheran Church" (ELC) with the name Norwegian omitted. Guess we should all be Americans by now.

April 25, 1948

Rev. Halverson preached his farewell sermon today. He, Esther and baby Luzanne are moving to Eau Claire. What will happen to us now?

October 3, 1948

Rev. E.A. Henderson was installed today by Rev. Axel Blom. Pastor Henderson preached a sermon on "Only a Witness" based on John 1:19-23. Rev. and Mrs. Henderson moved into the parsonage recently and are already hard at work, getting acquainted and making the wheels of the parish turn. He has an interesting printing press in the basement, and turns out some beautiful work.

March 6, 1949

Pastor Henderson dedicated our New Wurlitzer Electric 2 Manual Organ today. It will add much to the beauty of our worship service. Minnie Christianson is our organist and is well deserving of a new instrument. I'm sure she is glad to be finished with the old "push pedal" organ! Rev. Blom talked in the evening on "God Loves Music". The organ cost \$2,431.98 and was purchased from the Meyer-Seeger Music Co. in Appleton.

May 15, 1949

Our women were busy again today. They served a banquet for the Green Bay Circuit Brotherhood convention. Melvin Prestrud is the local president.

December 7, 1949

It's 80 years ago today that a small group of people met at Martinius Anderson's home for the first Norwegian Lutheran Service. What changes we have witnessed since then! Pastor Henderson had some booklets made and we had a small observance today, with plans being made for something bigger next year, probably during the better weather months. We are especially mindful today that our King Eternal has been leading us on from generation to generation and using us to spread His Word that all generations may worship Him.
