



## Ascension's 150th Anniversary

Planning is well underway for our year-long 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration in 2024!!

We will kick off the New Year with a traditional Norwegian activity of making lefse. We will be taking preorders only so an order sheet will be out sometime in November. We also have a sign-up sheet so people can help us make lefse in January.

Throughout the year we will have information in the newsletter about our history and also old articles on our bulletins boards. We also want to highlight the many benevolences we support by featuring them during the worship service on a monthly basis. We plan on having the youth and any adult members sing for shut-ins sometime in the Spring of the year so watch the announcements for that. In October during the Polka service we want to hold a reunion Sunday and invite all past and present members to attend. Since our church was officially organized on November 26, 1874 we plan to hold a special worship service on November 3<sup>rd</sup> and invite back all our past pastors. There will also be a dinner after the service with historical pictures to view. We also plan to have a memento of our 150th anniversary available for purchase. This is just an overview of the plans with more details to follow as we get closer to 2024.

**October** – We will have a Polka service and a reunion Sunday. We will invite past & present members with a fellowship following the worship service.

**November** – November 26, 1874 our church was officially organized. We will have a special worship service on November 3, 2024. We are inviting past pastors to join us. A chicken dinner will be served after the service to celebrate 150 years.

We have asked all the Benevolences we support through-out the year to come and tell us how our financial support benefits them.



## Way Back When

by David Prestrud

#### Mabel Irene (Christianson) Prestrud

Since 1972 my mother has been writing <u>Way</u>

<u>Back When</u> and, as you know, this December's issue was her last. I thought it would be appropriate if the first column of <u>I Remember When...</u> were about her. Her interest in history and fantastic memory have given me, and hopefully many of you, an understanding of the people and times that shaped Ascension and the Navarino community. Thanks to her I have volumes of stories and genealogy which has made it possible for me to write this brief biography.

Mabel was born on June 20, 1919 on the then Christianson farm in Navarino (where the Lew Erb farm is now) to Otto and Ellen (Peterson) Christianson. Otto was the son of Halvor and Ingeborg Christianson, both Norwegian immigrants. Ellen was the daughter of Julius and Anne Maria Peterson. Julius' father, Peder Larsen was a charter member of Ascension. It is the Peder Larsen family, of which there were eight children, through which many in Navarino can trace their roots.

As a young woman Mabel had several jobs including working for Lutsey's Jersey Dairy in Green Bay, at Montgomery Ward in Shawano, and as a clerk at the Shawano Library, a job that she loved and still talks about. Then came World War II and everyone was pressed into defense work. Mabel attended vocational school in Green Bay learning blue print reading and welding. She then worked at the Peterson Ship Builders in Sturgeon Bay as a welder! (She may not appreciate me mentioning this, but it is something I always thought was fascinating!) Luckily she was able to find a better job shortly in the accounting department at FWD in Clintonville, a job she held for 15 years.

At about this time (1950) she was asked to become the Organist at Ascension, a position she held for 32 years. (She had also been Ascension's organist for several years prior to this.) She played for nearly every wedding, funeral, and service during those years, which helps explain her detailed knowledge of the Ascension community.

On April 23, 1955 she married Melvin Prestrud, with Olga and Charlie Pues as attendants, and settled on the Prestrud farm (now Ken and Brenda Schultz's). David was born on December 11, 1957 (do the math!). Melvin's father and Mabel's mother and father lived with them on the farm until their deaths.

Mabel was an active member of the ALCW and served for many years as Secretary of Education on the Conference Board and eventually the District Board. This gave her the opportunity to travel to a number of national ALCW conventions at various cities around the country including San Antonio and San Francisco. She was so taken with San Francisco that many years later she surprised Melvin by taking him there after a trip to Colorado for a family reunion. He thought they were flying back to Green Bay and didn't know their destination until they landed!

In 1988 Melvin and Mabel sold their farm and moved to Shawano where they lived in apartment for a year where they quickly discovered that two country kids weren't cut out for apartment life. They bought a small house on the south side of town where they were very comfortable. Mabel is still there. Melvin passed away on August 6, 1996.

Mabel continues to play for services at the
Lunds church twice a year, has interpreted old
Norwegian church records for various
publications, and works regularly on genealogy.
Hopefully she will find the time to contribute to I
Remember When... on occasion. I can assure
you she has enough material for many more
editions.


#### **RECIPE OF THE MONTH - Salsa Chicken**
