## Message from the Pastor ~ Sunday Fellowship



Do we know the difference between gratitude and thankfulness? To be thankful is an emotion. Gratitude is an attitude of appreciation under any circumstances. We just celebrated Mother's Day. We are thankful for our mothers for what they do every day; things like cooking, washing laundry, cleaning house, and yet work outside of the home. This is a stereotype of what it means to be a mother in today's society. We set aside one day of the year to let her know how thankful we are that she is our mother. Our gratitude for her love and care is our appreciation for her being there when we need her. Your mother will always be in your heart. - Colton's future plans are to pursue either a Master's or PhD in Human Computer Interaction.

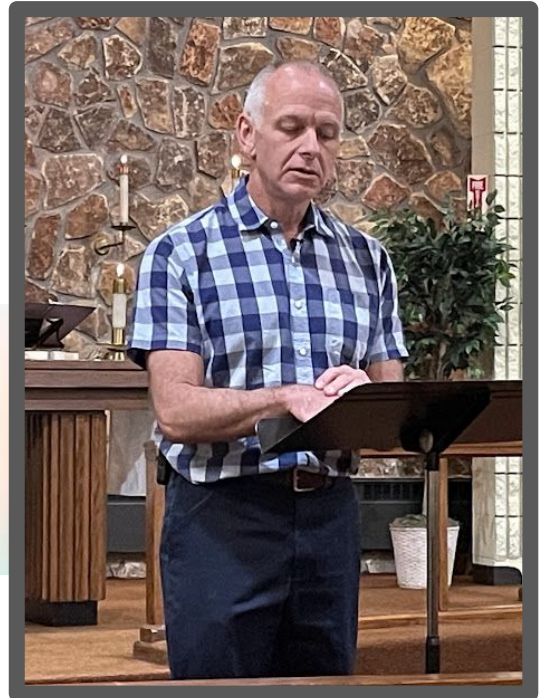

- Last year prepaid for 3500 gallons of gas to lock in pricing. We used 3418.3 gallons, \$71.05 was reimbursed for the unused portion of the prepaid gallons. Must use 80% to be reimbursed for unused gallons. We will prepay for 3500 gallons again this year.
- Letter received from the Town of Navarino regarding Rezoning from FP, Farmland & Forest Preservation Zoning District to the OAR, Open Lands, Agriculture & Residential Zoning District. A Public Hearing will be held at the Shawano County Courthouse on Wednesday June 5th at 9am.

## 'Way Back When by Mabel Prestrud

### *Bits and pieces from our history...*

According to the Treasurer's records from 1907, a total of \$101.50 was paid to Rev. J.P. Bugge for his services that year.

At a Congregational Meeting in 1917, three members (Anton Peterson, Berndt Anderson and Johnson Bentson) offered to furnish a load of wood each for heating the church. Four men (Christ Christianson, Lawrence Mathison, John Bentson and Otto Falk) were picked to solicit oats for Rev. Bugge's horses.

Every summer there was a session of 'Norske Skole' (Norwegian School - religion) held, with a teacher hired for the season. In 1917 the school was in session and Miss Blanche Johnson of the Town of Lessor was the teacher. Records show 29 students in attendance. They studied the Catechism, Bible history, the books of Mark and Luke in the New Testament, and memorized eight hymns.

In past year, October was the month for the annual Mission Fest. The Ladies Aid records show that at a meeting on October 5, 1927, the receipts from the dinner at the fest that year were \$23.30. Expenses were \$ .76, so the balance of \$22.54 was given to missions.

At the Ladies Aid meeting on November 4, 1931, it was decided to hold a chicken dinner on Thanksgiving Day. Here are some details from the planning:

- A 15 pound roast would be purchased (cost later showed \$2.88 for the meat).
- Norwegian pastry would be served.
- Those having small chickens would bring three, and those with large chickens would bring two.
- The charge for the dinner would be \$ .25 for adults and \$ .15 for children from 6-12 years.

From the Annual meeting of the Navarino Lutheran Congregation on January 21, 1936.

Motions were made seconded and carried that:

- The ladies be allowed to vote;
- The janitor's salary be raised to \$60.00 for the coming year;
- The organist get \$25.00 and three offerings;
- The receipts on Children's Day be given to the Sunday School Teachers;
- The envelope system be introduced;
- A committee be elected to investigate whether to build a basement under the church or build a hall.

The basement was built and dedicated on May 30, 1937. The Ladies Aid served dinner in their new spacious facilities. At a special meeting later that year a motion was made, seconded, and carried to wire the church for electricity.

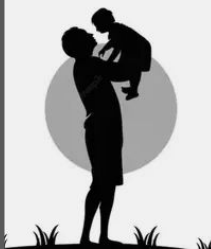
