Message from the Pastor ~ Bible Study Information



“I must listen to the Gospel, it tells me, not what I must do, but what Jesus Christ, the Son of God, has done for me.” Martin Luther.

As we continue to prepare our hearts during this holy season, do we remember what our hearts are being prepared for? Luther said, it is not what I do to be saved, but what God does through his Son. I ask you and me, are we preparing our hearts for the ultimate truth of God’s love in Jesus? Because of our sinful nature, Satan will guilt us by putting thoughts in our minds like: How can God love me? Look at all the bad things I have done. I’m not worthy of His love.

It isn’t easy to admit that we are responsible for the reason the Son of God/Son of Man came to earth to suffer, be handed over to His creation so that He will be crucified on a cross. **Deuteronomy 21:22-23**; *“When someone is convicted of a crime punishable by death and is executed and you hang him on a tree.... is under God’s curse....”* Jesus took our sins and put them on his shoulders. It wasn’t Jesus who was cursed; it is our sins, past, present, and future that are cursed. The wisdom of man is foolishness to God. The religious leaders did what God had designed. They thought if they did away with Jesus, everything would go back to “normal.” They would return to their prestigious roles under Jewish Law.

Like I stated earlier, Satan gets into our minds and makes us doubt how much God loves us. God does not guilt us into fear. God brings us back to his throne of grace and we declare; I am a child of God and I belong to Him. I am worthy because He says so.

We will experience the Passion of Jesus. We call it Good Friday - for it is the hour when Jesus takes all our sins and God was pleased to reconcile us to himself by making peace through the blood of His cross. **Colossians 1:19** (*paraphrased*)

The disciples were overwhelmed and afraid of the events they would witness. Jesus said to his disciples three times what was going to happen to him and he gave them the message of victory, “the Son of Man will rise again in three days.” The disciples were not waiting for Jesus’ resurrection. They were afraid of the religious leaders because they were disciples of Jesus. They locked themselves in the place where Jesus instituted the Lord’s Supper. The Pharisees never found the disciples, but Jesus did. Everything has changed.

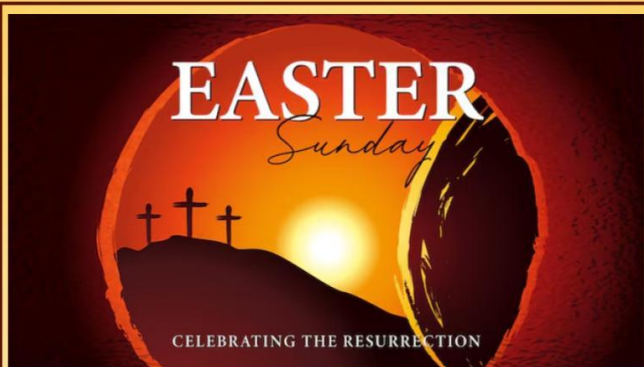

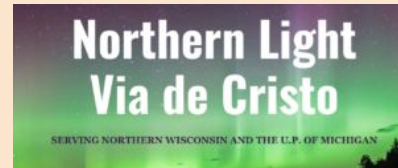

I took a trip to Jamaica the last week of February. I went with my husband Doug and 13 others to celebrate my cousin's 25th wedding anniversary. This was only my 2nd time flying out of the country and my 5th time flying overall. While flying is exhilarating it also gives me much anxiety. On an airplane, the passengers have absolutely no control over anything that may happen during take-off or landing or in the air. There always seems to be some turbulence and all anyone can do is stay in their seat and buckle up.

Flying really isn't that much different from life. No one is spared the turbulence that comes from living here on earth. My most turbulent time of my life was in July 1997. My first pregnancy ended in a stillbirth. Doug and I were devastated. I didn't know how to navigate life with a broken heart and empty arms. There were days I didn't want to go on and breaking down in tears was a common occurrence. I begged God to tell me why. I was so angry with Him that I was ready to turn my back on Him. How could I love and trust a God who would allow so much pain? One day I got my answer. As I was pleading with God to tell me why he allowed this to happen I heard, "I did this to bring you closer to Me." Wow! The promise that I will one day be reunited with my daughter is real, all because of Jesus death and resurrection. I believe in the promise of the resurrection and I hope you all do too!
